A team of four former students of JMI won awards in Harbin International Ice and Snow Sculpture Competition, China

‘Abhyuday’, a team consisting of four former students of Faculty of Fine Arts, JMI won two Excellence Award and one Special Award in International Ice and Snow Sculpture Competition held at Harbin, China. Ravi Prakash, Sunil Kumar Kushwaha, Mohd. Sultan Alam and Rajnish Verma are the team members who did their graduation from Department of Sculpture, Faculty of fine Arts, JMI. Ravi Prakash is a guest faculty also at the Faculty of Fine Arts. The team represented India at the competition held at Harbin, China.

The team participated in three back to back events at the championship held recently. In first competition they’ve created a 9 feet tall, 10 feet in length and 8 feet wide ice sculpture of ‘Kaliya’. The team won Award of Excellence for their creation.

Second Ice sculpture event in which 34 teams of 16 countries participated, team ‘Abhyuday’ created an ice sculpture of ‘Garuda’ which was 6 feet tall, 6 feet in length and 3 feet in width. The team won Award of Excellence for their creation.

The third competition was an International Snow Sculpture competition in which 29 teams of 16 countries. Team ‘Abhyuday’ won special award and prize money for their creation of snow sculpture of ‘Narsimha’.
