# **About the Workshop**

The Department of Geography, Jamia Millia Islamia, New Delhi is organizing one week online workshop for Research scholars and PG Students. The programme is sponsored by the UGC-DRS SAP-I.

Development of geo-spatial technique is crucial for scientific exploration of the earth's system, such as hydrosphere, lithosphere and biosphere. The phenomenon of the earth's system such as natural and human-induced has much significance in today's world. Remote sensing and GIS are modern technologies with timely and accurate information. Information access through these technologies helps to monitor and analyze a wide range of phenomena like water, soil, vegetation, and human health. It also helps to explore the potential natural resources for human use. Therefore, it is being used widely in various disciplines and multidisciplinary subject areas for decision-making and problem-solving processes.

The human–environment interaction (HEI) plays a key role in the dynamics of global environmental system. HEI analysis uses disparate datasets for every particular study. However, there are some similarities between methods and techniques in remote sensing and GIS practitioners. It creates an inter-disciplinary study in HEI and collaboration between authors of various disciplines. Increased collaboration beyond academics is also seen nowadays by stakeholders and decision makers for real world applications. Remote sensing and GIS provide information through data mining and processing. Therefore, remote sensing and GIS are crucial for providing potential solutions to the problems.

The aim of the workshop is to get the participants acquainted with the use of methods/tools for research problem analysis. The workshop is oriented towards providing end to end knowledge of the application of remote sensing and GIS in solving real world problems. Therefore, this workshop will help to understand the uses and application of geo-spatial technique.

## About Jamia Millia Islamia

Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) is one of the premier universities of national importance. The Department is a pioneer in the country introducing Remote Sensing at post graduate level as recognized by the ISRO, Government of India, and supported for the enhancement of the DIP/GIS labs. The DST also recognized the Department as nodal facility in Delhi for funding training programmes in Remote Sensing and GIS for university and college teachers and DST accorded department FIST-1 status in 2016. A year later in 2017 UGC recognized the Department to support it under SAP DRS-1.

Department comes under the Faculty of Natural Sciences and has built its reputation in the country for imparting education in Remote Sensing and GIS. Publications by the faculty and research scholars in international journals with about eight hundred of citations, and twenty five h-index have added colour to the department.
