## Week-long World Congress on Deleuze and Guattari to kickstart next week as part of Jamia Centenary Celebrations

The Centre for Culture, Media and Governance is organising Deleuze and Guattari World Congress 2020, as part of Jamia Millia Islamia's centenary celebrations. The Congress will be held from 17<sup>th</sup> January to 22<sup>nd</sup> January and will consist of a camp and a conference spread over three days each.
