Centre for Physiotherapy and Rehabilitation Sciences (CPRS), Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI), celebrated World Physiotherapy Week from 3rd September 2025 to 8th September 2025, with a series of academic, sports, and community outreach activities focusing on the theme of "Healthy Ageing: Preventing Falls and Frailty in Older Adults."

The week-long programme included seminars, sports events, physiotherapy camps, and cultural activities. As a part of the programme a seminar on "Healthy Ageing: Preventing Falls and Frailty in Older Adults" was held on 3rd September 2025 at the Centre for Information and Technology (CIT). The event was inaugurated by Prof. Mazhar Asif, Vice Chancellor of JMI, along with Prof. Dr. Yagna Shukla, Chairperson, National Commission for Allied and Healthcare Professions (NCAHP), and Prof. Zahid Ashraf, Dean, Faculty of Life Sciences. Distinguished speakers from AllMS, New Delhi — Dr. Richa Mallick, Dr. Pooja Vijay Shevale, and Dr. Shivani Shailaja — delivered lectures on frailty management, physiotherapy interventions, and nutrition in ageing. Sports day was organised on 4th September 2025 to encourage physical activity and team spirit. Events included relay race, 400-metre race, 100-metre race, push-ups, volleyball, tug of war and many more. Students and faculty enthusiastically participated, highlighting the importance of exercise in maintaining strength and coordination.

On 6th September a Free Physiotherapy Camp was organised at Hope Project Charitable Trust, Basti Hazrat Nizamuddin, New Delhi. The camp aimed to bridge healthcare gaps by providing free physiotherapy consultations to the underprivileged community. Supported by an exemplary team of faculty, physiotherapists, and volunteers from final-year BPT and MPT programmes, the camp successfully catered to 138 patients, offering treatments for musculoskeletal and mobility issues.

A Free Physiotherapy Health Camp was also organised at the CPRS Clinic, JMI on the 4^{th} , 6^{th} and 8^{th} of September 2025. Over the course of three days of the camp, a total of 110 patients availed free physiotherapy consultations, detailed clinical assessments, and personalised treatment advice. The camp was supervised by dedicated faculty members. The last day of the Physiotherapy Week on 8^{th} September 2025 observed the photography competition where the students participated actively showcasing their photography skills. The judges of the competition included – Mr. William Chang.

The week-long celebrations concluded with a Valedictory Session graced by distinguished guests: Prof. Neelofer Afzal, Dean of Student Welfare and Professor, Department of Electronics & Communication Engineering, Prof. Mohammad Zahid Ashraf, Dean, Faculty of Life Sciences, Jamia Millia Islamia. Dr. Nihal Ashraf, Physiotherapist and Career Coach and Mr. J.K.L. Prasad, Business Development Manager, AD instruments delivered talks. The position holders in academics and winners of the various sports competitions were also awarded. The celebrations concluded on a positive note, promoting health, active living, and community engagement.




