**JMI's Department of Art History and Art Appreciation hosts an Art Exhibition and Exhibition Design Workshop to commemorate 75 years**

New Delhi, April 1, 2026

The exhibition design workshop was conducted by Mr. Oroon Das and was structured in two parts. The first session focused on developing an understanding of space and meaning within exhibition design, encouraging participants to think critically about how narratives are constructed through spatial arrangements. The second part involved a hands-on activity, where students were divided into groups and assigned tasks to conceptualize and design their own exhibition proposals, fostering collaborative thinking and practical engagement.

Alongside the workshop, the exhibition titled "Across the Shoulder: The Upper Drapes in Indigenous Textiles" was held from 25th to 27th March 2026. Curated and organized by students of the Department of Art History and Art Appreciation, the exhibition explored indigenous textiles through their making process—pre-loom, on-loom, and post-loom stages. By presenting textiles across these phases, the exhibition highlighted the material, cultural, and labor-intensive aspects of textile traditions, offering viewers a comprehensive understanding of their significance within indigenous practices.
