Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MMTTC), JMI concludes its 8-Days online NEP-2020 Orientation & Sensitization Programme.

New Delhi, September 2, 2026

Malaviya Mission Teacher Training Centre (MMTTC), Jamia Millia Islamia (JMI) concluded its 44th 8-Days online NEP-2020 Orientation & Sensitization Programme w.e.f. 21st to 31st August, 2026. The programme was organized in collaboration with A.N.D. Teachers Training (P.G.) College, Sitapur. It was attended by 181 members, including Professors, Associate Professors, Assistant Professors, Research scholars, and educators representing central, state, deemed, and private universities and colleges across several states and from diverse disciplines.

The programme was organized under the patronage of Prof. Mazhar Asif, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, JMI (Chief Patron), Prof. Mahtab Alam Rizvi, Registrar, (Patron), and Prof. S.P. Singh, Principal A.N.D. Teachers Training (P.G.) College, Sitapur. The concept of the programme was envisioned by Prof. Kulwinder Kaur, Director, MMTTC, and coordinated by Prof. Sunil Kumar, Department of Teacher Education, A.N.D. Teachers Training (P.G.) College.

On the first day, the programme commenced with a welcome address by Prof. Kaur, who highlighted the role of NEP-2020 towards promoting multidisciplinary education in contemporary times. Prof. Sunil Kumar gave an overview of the programme and introduced the inaugural speaker, Prof. Mohd. Mahmood Siddiqui from the Department of Teachers Training, Maulana Azad National Urdu University, Hyderabad. In his address, Prof. Siddiqui, outlined the transformative vision of NEP-2020, emphasizing the importance of flexible curricular structures, research promotion, and innovation-driven learning. The second session on the integration of Indian Knowledge Systems in curriculum development was delivered by Prof. Sarika Sharma, Department of Educational Studies, JMI, in which she emphasized on governance reforms and institutional mechanisms for effective policy implementation.

On the second day, Prof. Reena Agarwal, Faculty of Education, University of Lucknow delivered a lecture on experiential learning, mental health and well-being emphasizing learner-centric pedagogy and measurable learning outcomes. This was followed by a session on research and development by Prof. Kaushal Kishore, Department of Educational Studies, JMI. New Delhi who talked about the basic constituents of research.

On the third day, Prof. Bharti Sharma, JMI, New Delhi delivered a lecture on types of learner and learning disabilities. The second session on curriculum development, pedagogy and assessment was conducted by Prof. Gyanendra Nath Tiwari from the Department of

Education, Central University of Nagaland, who discussed the academic bank of credits, national credit framework, multiple entry-exit system, and skill hubs in higher education. Day four began with a lecture on NEP's approach to curriculum flexibility and competency based design by Prof. Pranita Singh from A.N.D. Teachers Training College, Sitapur. The next session by Prof. Vaibhav Sabnees from Department of English, Babasaheb Ambedkar College of Law, Maharashtra, focused on the life skills, critical thinking, communication, and creativity required in the 21st Century.

On the fifth day, Prof. Amit Jaiswal, Dean, Faculty of Education, Sri Dev Suman University, Uttarakhand spoke on the academic, financial and administrative autonomy as well as accountability. For the next session, Prof. Anindya Syam Choudhury, Dean, Central University of Assam, Silchar, and also a Visiting Professor, at Tan-Tao University, Vietnam, discussed integrating traditional Indian knowledge traditions with modern academic disciplines.

On the sixth day, Prof. Rahela Farooqi, Department of Management Studies, JMI, spoke on Placements and Internships in FYUP as per the NEP-2020 Perspective. She highlighted the need for curriculum restructuring and employability-oriented education. In the second session, Dr. Alok Kumar Upadhyay, School of Continuing Education, IGNOU, New Delhi, discussed the barriers and remedies for Equity, Accessibility and Diversity for SLD Groups.

On the seventh day, Prof. Munesh Kumar, Department of Education, University of Lucknow, highlighted the role of academic leadership in HEIs towards accountability to society. This was followed by a session on challenges in academic leadership by Prof. Anshu Kedia, Principal, Khunkhunji Girls (P.G.) College, Lucknow, who discussed the strategies to address professional stress and maintain work-life balance for educators.

The next academic session on Smart Blended Learning through AI centric design was delivered by Prof. Amit Gautam, Department of School and Non-Formal Education, NIEPA, New Delhi. He highlighted the growing role of digital technologies, online learning platforms, and blended learning approaches in transforming higher education. The programme concluded with the last session by Sr. Professor, Manoj Kumar Saxena, Former Head and Dean, School of Education, Central University of Himachal Pradesh, Dharmshala, HP. In his lecture, he engaged the participants with issues of plagiarism in research in very interactive manner. The talk was highly appreciated by all.

An MCQ-based assessment, covering the themes discussed during the programme, was conducted on the final day. The programme concluded with a feedback session taken by Prof. Kulwinder Kaur. Participants appreciated the insightful lectures, interdisciplinary discussions, and the seamless organization of the orientation programme. They also gave suggestions for topics that may be covered in future programmes. Over the span of eight days, the programme fostered rich deliberations on NEP implementation to reinforce commitment to inclusive education, research & development and curriculum innovations.

LEARNING FROM PRACTICE

Institutions Already Building These Mechanisms

AICTE-mandated IPCs
All AICTE-approved technical institutions are required to set up Industry-Institute Partnership Cells to formalise MoUs, internships and joint projects.

Community Colleges under UGC/NSQF Scheme
Many colleges run UGC's Community College/B.Voc. framework, embedding on-the-job training and industry internships directly into the degree.

ITIs & NITs — Centralised T&P Cells
Dedicated, faculty-headed placement offices running pre-placement talks, phased placement schedules and long-standing recruiter relationships.

Corporate Resource / Career Centres
A number of universities run dedicated Corporate Resource Centres that combine internship placement, alumni relations and start-up incubation under one roof.

State Skill Development Missions
Several state missions (e.g., under Skill India Mission) partner directly with universities to run NSQF-aligned certificate add-ons alongside degree programmes.

Apprenticeship-embedded Degrees
Institutions using the National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS)/NATS portal to convert internships into paid, structured apprenticeships with industry stipends.
