**JMI achieves 'Outstanding Performance' on the targets set for evaluation by the MHRD**

It is a matter of pride for the Jamia Millia Islamia(JMI) to achieve an outstanding performance in a performance evaluation done by the Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD).

For the year 2019-20, JMI has secured 95.23% score in an overall assessment, as indicated in a letter sent by the MHRD. This is an indication that the administration and faculty members are highly focussed on achieving the target and have potential to deliver.

With an objective to measure the performance of the Central Universities(CUs) on selected key parameters against the targets set so as to improve the performance on the critical parameters of the organisation, all the CUs are required to sign a tripartite MoU with MHRD and UGC. JMI was the first university in 2017 to sign this MoU and presented itself for performance evaluation.

Performance was evaluated based on the parameters such as student diversity and equity, faculty quality and strength, academic outcomes, research performance, outreach, governance, finance, national & international rankings and accreditation and co and extracurricular activities.

Prof. Najma Akhtar, Vice Chancellor, JMI expressed her happiness and satisfaction over the performance and said that the achievement is all the more significant because of the challenging time the university has gone through in the recent past.

She attributed the achievement to high quality teaching, relevant and focused research of highest quality & improved perception of the university and hoped to improve the performance in the coming years.

JMI Rankings:

It is worth mentioning here that in MHRD's NIRF, JMI has been ranked at the 10th position in the country in universities category, improving its position from 12th last

year. In ‘overall category’ the university has been placed at 16th position, enhancing its ranking from 19th last year. IITs, IIMs, IISc, other top technical institutions and universities are included in the overall category.

JMI maintained its position for the third consecutive year in the coveted Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Rankings-2021. JMI retained its rank at 751-800 even as the number of universities getting ranked by QS increased this year.

The university has shown significant improvement in the Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) India University Rankings 2020 which has ranked the university at 21 position, improving its ranking at 28 in 2019.

JMI was among the very few academic institutions from India which had improved its position in London-based Times Higher Education (THE) World University Rankings 2020 released in September 2019. From 801-1000, JMI improved its position to 601-800 in the rankings. After the first 200 ranks, THE rankings put institutes into rank groups rather than individual ranks.

JMI has been ranked at 538 positions worldwide by Moscow-based Round University Ranking (RUR) 2020 among the world’s 1100 universities assessed, improving its position from 631 last year.

Outlook-ICARE India University Rankings 2019 has placed the university at 3rd position among the top 25 Central Universities and at 17th rank among top 100 universities in India last July.
