Three week Leadership for Academician Programme (LeAP) begins at JMI

A three - week Leadership for Academician Programme (LeAP) of the MHRD, GOI began on 10 March 2019 at Jamia Millia Islamia. This programme will continue till 19 March 2019. Foreign component of the programme will start from 25 March to 30 March 2019 at the University of Virginia, USA. Distinguished delegates from different institutions of higher education of India are participating in this flagship programme of the MHRD, Government of India.

The main objectives of the LeAP is to develop competency and skills amongst educational leaders to handle the complex issues and leadership challenges that arise in educational administrations.
